



Entry Details for **SCALA** Civic Building of the Year Competition 2012 and Yearbook



Have you recently been involved in a publicly funded development of which you are proud? If you have, and you believe it to be worthy of recognition, you should enter the project for this prestigious competition!

Each year SCALA makes an award to the client and designers of the best building entered for **The Civic Building of the Year Competition**.

The objective is to promote the development of high quality public buildings through the formal recognition of excellence in design and construction.

Entries for the Competition and/or submissions for publication in the Yearbook can be made by initially submitting a small number of good quality photographs. Each set of photo's should be accompanied by a short description of the project, its value, completion date, and the contact details (e-mail address/telephone number etc.) of the client or organisation making the submission.

The closing date for submissions is Monday 16th Jan 2012 (but submissions before Christmas would be much appreciated).

Eligibility

- Schemes must have been completed between October 1st 2010 and October 31st 2011.
- Schemes must have received a substantial proportion of Public Funding (this includes PFI and similarly funding).
- There is no limit to the number of schemes submitted by any one practice or client.

How to submit schemes

Select not more than 6 photos (prints or on a CD) of the scheme, fill in the form overleaf and send them by post to: David Kimmins, 39 Main Street, Keyworth, Nottingham NG12 5AA

PLEASE NOTE

Digital photos for publication MUST be at least 300dpi at 18cm wide. However, if you haven't got this resolution level by the submission date send in what you've got and follow up with high resolution images later.

The jury will consider all the entries and produce a short list of about 8 to 10 schemes in February 2012.

Clients and Designers of shortlisted schemes will be contacted for further details and panel members will visit the schemes.

Each project will be awarded points for various elements of the design and construction, on a similar basis as the CIC Design Quality Indicator system.

Following completion of the visits, the results will be analysed and further visits made by all members of the Panel to the potential winners.

The results of the Competition will be announced in the autumn of 2012 at the President's Dinner, held on the evening of the Seminar Day of the SCALA Conference.

The winning client and designers will be presented with a handsome engraved glass plaque designed to be mounted on the building. Highly Commended and Commended Certificates will also be awarded to schemes from the short list. The majority of the projects will then published in **Scalanews** during the course of the following year.
